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Dear Mr. & Mrs. Helm:

In accordance with Rule 305 of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC"), this letter serves as a 30-day notice by Pronghorn Operating LLC ("Pronghorn") of its intention to drill a new well at the above captioned location. Pronghorn operations are estimated to begin within the next 30 days pending receipt of required permits, approval of title, and drilling rig availability. COGCC regulations provide that the surface owner may waive the 30-day notice requirement.


Rule 306 of the COGCC requires written notice from the surface owner to request or waive a consultation meeting with Pronghorn concerning the location of the above referenced well and all associated equipment.

Enclosed is a waiver and request for consultation form. Please read and fill out stating your decision on the 30-day notice and consultation meeting as required by Rule 305 & 306 of the COGCC. Return the fully executed form in the envelope provided. Also enclosed, is the Surface Owner's Information Brochure from the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.

As the surface owner, it is your responsibility to notify and affected tenant farmer, lessee or other party that may own or have an interest in any crops or surface improvements that could be affected by these proposed operations.
