As discussed in our January 28, 2014 meeting, Marathon will not meet the March 3, 2014 Form 15 extension deadline for completion of all outstanding Form 28 actions and intends to continue operating the 32C Pond within all other COGCC regulations with COGCC oversight. Marathon proposes to submit to you on a weekly basis an e-mail that provides the status of pending actions and a timeline for working through the Garfield County Limited Impact Review process. This week's actions are as follows:

Status of COGCC Facility ID #433736 - (March 8-14)

1) Garfield County Limited Impact Review – On Tuesday, March 11th Glenn Hartmann, Senior Planner for Garfield County sent a letter to Alex Fischer of the COGCC providing an update as to the status of Garfield County's review of Marathon's 32C Produced Water Pond LIR Application. As of Friday, March 14, Marathon has not received a response from Garfield County as to Marathon's request for the access roadway issue to be managed separate from the 32C LIR.
