Ladies and Gentlemen,

High Sierra Water Services LLC has applied for permits to drill the above referenced wells with the described surface locations on property neighboring yours. Rule 603.a(2) of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) stipulates that the surface location of a well must be no less than 150' from a property line. As planned above, these two wells fall 84' and 68' from your property line. 
