Good morning Melissa,

- 1). Aus-Tex is currently in discussion with Gregg Clasemann's attorney and we anticipate an executed surface use agreement within the next week. I will submit the executed agreement to the commission upon receipt.
- 2). Aus-Tex and myself have been working with Fremont County to fulfill all requested notices and required permits.

The operator concurs to the following changes:

- 1) The COGCC will change the Interim Reclamation date to 10/10/2014 for compliance with Rule 1003b.
- 2) The COGCC will change the estimated depth to groundwater to 150 feet based on surrounding wells with reported static water levels.

Aus-Tex will abide by the COA's listed below.

- 1) Operator will apply appropriate measures to ensure dust control and mitigate potential impacts resulting from dust emissions.
- 2) Operator will ensure compliance with Rule 318e (Wells located near a mine).
