COGCC has reviewed the Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan for the North Platte K-22 Pad submitted by Bonanza Creek Energy Operating Company on March 31, 2014. Based on the information presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time, and COGCC approves the closure request.

However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soil exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site.
