Callie,

I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and have the following comments.

1) In the Land Use section you have indicated this oil and gas location is on Irrigated Cropland. However, a review of your Location Pictures and aerial photographs indicates this oil and gas location is not on Irrigated Cropland, but what appears to be best categorized as Rangeland. Therefore, the Plant Community section needs to be completed. Please review the Location Pictures and the Plant Community section and provide me with that information to complete the Plant Community section and I will update the 2A.

2) Your Location Drawing shows several existing small production facilities (a meter shack, and several tanks) immediately to the west and southwest of your proposed oil and gas location. Are any of these existing facilities Great Western's and if so will they be removed and replaced by this proposed Cornish Off-site Tank Battery location?

3) Due to the estimated depth to groundwater (8 feet) in the area of this oil and gas location, I will change the Sensitive Area designation from NO to YES in the Water Resources section.
