RE: Request to Test Water Well

Dear Mr. Rich:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that EE3 LLC. (EE3) has permitted, or is in the process of permitting an oil and gas well in the vicinity of your property near the intersection of Jackson County Road (JCR) 24 and Highway 14.

Per the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Rule 609, EE3 is requesting access to your water well to obtain a baseline water sample. This baseline water sample will document the pre-existing conditions of the aquifer in the location of your water well. Should there be any problems in the future, after the oil and gas well has been completed, this baseline water data can be compared to potential future sampling results.

EE3 is requesting your permission for LT Environmental, Inc. (LTE) to access your property in order to have your water well, which is known as the Well Receipt No. 9118918, located in NENE Quarter, Township 7 North, Range 80 West, Section 5, sampled by LTE and tested by an independent laboratory. The costs for sampling and testing will be paid by EE3. By signing the enclosed postcard, which authorizes the sampling and testing, you are recognizing that your water well may be inoperable for approximately one hour during testing. Results from the water well sampling event will be provided to you, the landowner, EE3 and the COGCC. This sampling program is a requirement per COGCC Rule 609.

Please indicate either of the options noted on the enclosed postcard, then sign and mail the postcard with pre-paid postage, to LTE, at the indicated address. Your prompt response to this request is greatly appreciated. Once we receive your consent, you will be contacted by LTE to schedule a mutually agreeable time to test your water well.
