BBC proposes to run the following on one of the first wells on the above-referenced multi-well pad:

| Log Type                          | Interval  |
|-----------------------------------|---|
| Cased-hole neutron with gamma ray | Intermediate hole - deepest depth obtainable in the 7" casing to ground level |

BBC proposes to run the following on all wells on the above-referenced multi-well pad:

| Log Type | Interval                       |
|----------|--------------------------------|
| CBL/GR   | Top of liner hanger to surface |
| MWD w/GR | KOP to TD                      |
| Mud      | KOP to TD                      |

The Form 5 will report that alternative logs were run per a Rule 317.o Exception and will identify the well (with API#, well name & well number) that was logged with the alternative logs. The form 5 will also include a comment that no open-hole logs were run.
