

Jay,

This email is to inform you that we have observed bradenhead pressures on a well in the Rulison field on our RWF 23-25 pad.

RWF 413-25 (API 05-045- 21981)

- This is a recently completed well. This well was completed from 4/9/2014 – 4/24/2014
- The TOC was called at 5174'
- The geologist pick for top of Mesa Verde was 4873'
- The geologist pick for top of gas was 6418'
- Highest observed bradenhead pressure 450psi.

With your permission, I would like to run a hard line to a tank and vent the bradenhead pressure for 90 days. This tank is currently plumbed into a carbon filter system that will capture a majority of emissions. After the 90 days, we will perform a 14 day build up and notify you of the pressure. If pressure has been eliminated, no further action will be required. If pressure has not been eliminated, we will make plans to remediate.

A sundry to vent will be submitted shortly. Given the well will build to 450 psi in a short amount of time, I'd like verbal permission to vent until the sundry can be approved.
