Thanks for the info – I recognize that it is picky – but could you please put just the answers to the Skid questions in an e-mail for the 'approval' confirmation? The email is an attachment to the new permit and so the details should be in the email itself.

I would suggest that the new well does have some indicator as to it is not the same exact well. Too often, when the name(number) is not changed, then things get filed on the wrong API and it can be tough to unwind. It can be as simple as an 'X' or an 'R' in the well number.
