This letter is for clarification purposes related to the future WPX Energy Rocky Mountain, LLC ("WPX") GM 21-12 Well Pad. Upon review of this location, WPX did not find that there were any "Building Units" located within the 1000' buffer of the Well Pad. The nearest location that would meet COGCC series 100 definition of a "Building Unit" is located 1003' from the separator on the well pad. WPX had a meeting with this building owner, Garfield County Housing Authority, on March 17, 2014 and has continued to have an open dialog with this property owner.

In addition, WPX outreach activities related to this location included a briefing to the Town of Parachute Town Council on March 13, 2014 and a door to door canvassing of the neighborhoods in the vicinity of the location on April 14, 2014. Future WPX activities include a neighborhood BBQ on June 12, 2014.
