Not sure that they are out of service. Hanson told me they had been shut in for 10 days. My PET said a crew was working on netting on Monday. Hanson was also telling me about a plan to do away with the ponds and use an injection well. I asked if they were going to do away with the tank battery and install a state of the art oil/water separator. He said something about removing the tanks piece meal. I didn't particularly like the sound of that.

The State Office vacated our order from May 2013 due to a procedural error. So we are starting from square one again. If you are working on a site investigation and remedial plan, I may want to hold off on issuing new orders for soil testing.
