COGCC received the Wright Oil Skim Pit Material Landfarm Report before the April 30, 2014 deadline specified in the Compliance Letter from the Colorado Attorney General's office (document #2148285). The report was also consistent with approved plans and included the information required by COGCC except for the following items:

- One discrete (grab) sample was reportedly collected, however, the approved Waste Management Plan (document # 01761385) specifies collection of composite samples. That said, COGCC accepts the sampling approach for this sampling event. Collecting a composite sample would be appropriate for future events.
- An unspecified amount of cow manure was reportedly added to the impacted soil. In the next Semi-Annual Report, list the quantities of all added material/amendments and include relevant details (i.e. composted or uncomposted cow manure).
