Per our earlier phone conversation, the following summarizes Whiting's plan to bring closure to the remaining 5 pits in the Boies Ranch area (Federal 397-3K-K3, Federal 397-3G-G1 NE & SW, Boies C-27A-H3, Boies C-28P-P3) :

Tuesday May 27<sup>th</sup> a Request For Proposal was sent out via email to several contractors.

Wednesday June 11<sup>th</sup> a pre-bid meeting will be held at the Boies Ranch field office along with visits to each of the 5 pits to be remediated.

Friday June 27<sup>th</sup> all proposals are due to Whiting for review.

Friday July 4<sup>th</sup> all workplans are due to Whiting for review.

Early July, selection of contractors and submittal of the work plans and Form 27's to COGCC.

Begin remediation in July upon approval from the COGCC.
