Based on review of information submitted to date, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time, and COGCC approves the request to close this drilling pit complex. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards, or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site. The pit, Facility ID#113100, and the remediation project (#7280) have been changed to closed status in the Colorado Oil & Gas Information System (Document #200403315). Note that final surface reclamation must meet COGCC Series 1000 rules. I have corrected the location of the pits on the COGIS database (40,310324 latitude and -107.401581 longitude) following our discussion. Please retain a copy of this email as verification of COGCC's No Further Action determination.
