Jim,

I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil and Gas Location Assessment and have a few comments.

- 1) Your Facility Layout Drawing shows there will be several buildings on this oil and gas location. These should be included in the Facilities list. Please provide me with the number and type of all buildings that are planned for this oil and gas location and I will add them to the Form 2A.
- 2) In the Construction section you have indicated the size of the location after interim reclamation will be the same as during construction (6 acres). In other words, no interim reclamation will take place. This is not in compliance with our Rules. Specifically Rule 1003.b. requires interim reclamation to occur in areas no longer in use. At a minimum, it appears from your Facility Layout Drawing that the area of the location south of your Access Road can be interim reclaimed. Please provide me with a revised size of the location after interim reclamation.
- 3) In the Plant Community section you did not complete all the required questions because the "Site was covered when pictures taken" As this Form 2A was not submitted until early June, you had time to gather the Plant Community information before submitting. Please provide me the missing plant species and plant community information.
- 4) A review of the information you provided in the Water Resources section indicates the nearest water well is Permit #294123, owned by Expedition and is 197 feet away. Therefore, I will change the distance to the nearest water well from 836 feet to 197 feet. Because this water well will also supply drinking water to people on the location, I will also change the Sensitive Area designation from NO to YES.

Please respond to this correspondence by July 9, 2014. If you have any question, please contact me. Thank you.

Regarding your questions/concerns below for the Expedition Water Solutions, LLC – EWS 1 SWD Well:

1. Facility: please add 2 buildings planned, the front building (Closest to the truck turnaround) will be an office and the other will be a pump house in the back. I can't find in the Rules where it asks for this though – Rule 303.b.(3)C says: "A list of major equipment components to be used in conjunction with drilling and operating the well(s), including all tanks, pits, flares, combustion equipment, separators, and other ancillary equipment and the description of any pipelines for oil, gas, or water."
2. Size of location after interim reclamation in acres: 1 (Sorry – I had entered a typo).
3. This location is on Cropland: specifically Pasture according to the Survey and according to Rule 303.b.(3)G.i: "If the final land use includes residential, industrial/commercial, or cropland and does not include any other uses, the land use should be indicated and no further information is needed." I have submitted this other data numerous times when cropland was checked and specifically told not to include the Plant Community data – never-the-less I have attached the data you requested.
4. I had included all of this information in the Notes Box under Water Resources – and agree the closest water well is 197'.

Please let me know if you need anything else.
