Kerr-McGee Oil and Gas Onshore LP (Kerr-McGee) is submitting this letter report as an update to the Centralized Exploration and Production Waste Management Facility Permit Application submitted on April 30, 2014 for the DFMF #2 Strear Farms Land Application Site (Site). The Site is located in the SW Section 23-T2N-R67W. This report describes the detailed site closure plan to be implemented at the Site once land application of water-based bentonitic drilling fluids and associated drill cuttings has been discontinued.

Upon closure of the Site, the soil conditions are anticipated to have improved sufficiently such that the property can be used solely for agricultural purposes. Closure soil sampling will be conducted across the Site prior to returning the Site to agricultural use. The Site will be divided into sixteen pods to ensure representative soil sample distribution (see attached figure). The pods range in area from 4.67 acres to 9.97 acres. One four-point composite soil sample will be collected from each pod at a depth of 0-6 inches. The soil samples will be analyzed for the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Table 910-1 soil parameters to confirm compliance with COGCC allowable levels. If necessary, soil amendments will be added to the top soil to bring soil conditions back into compliance with COGCC allowable levels.

Once the site closure criteria are achieved, a Site Closure Report detailing the analytical results will be submitted to the COGCC for approval and subsequent No Further Action (NFA) determination. At that time, the perimeter fence, signage, containment berms, stormwater controls, and any unnecessary roads will be removed and the Site will be returned to agricultural use.


