Hi Shawna,

The Form 4 was approved with a 6-month extension while surface access issues are addressed (see Document #400448361). New due date is December 30, 2013. Both NOAVs have been revised to reflect this.

The Form 27 for the 3rd spill needs to be revised to reflect the subsurface nature of this spill. Proposed remediation only addresses the extent of surface impacts. The subsurface impacts associated with the leaking underground pipeline need to be addressed in this plan. Those impacts cannot be left in-place until a new pipeline is installed - they must be addressed with the spill report/cleanup.

Please discuss w/ your client, revise and resubmit.
