Mr Freemyer: Veach Land needs confirmation that you are indeed the Attorney and Registered Agent for Monument Global Resources Inc, Also a list of owners for Monument Global.

At no time has Veach Land LLLP asked Monument to Stop production, Veach Land only asked for the oil spill to be stopped. Veach Land gave permission to Tom Fox to apply an absorbent on the third spill on June 11, 2013. The same date Veach Land LLLP made Monument aware of the third spill, by notifying Tom Fox by cell phone with a witness in the vehicle. Corey Veach owns Veach Land LLLP and Casey Veach is the other owner, as you are well aware.

The location of the spills are documented by the (COGCC) who issued a Alleged Violation to Monument Global Resources Inc.

the Oil and Gas Lease you refer to does not affect the gross oil spill land damages witch Monument Global Resources Inc. is responsible for, Even though Monument claims to the COGCC that it was Smith Energy's spill, which is not factual, That is first mistake Monument made.

The second is they did not claim the spill to the COGCC in a timely manner, took six months for that to happen.

The third mistake is having the BLM claim it was under Five Barrels, on a spill that ran over 1/4 of a mile.

The forth mistake is not reporting to the Landowner about any of the spills.

The fifth mistake is not reporting the second spill to the COGCC and then not cleaning it up.

The sixth mistake is damaging the Landowner's top soil to cover up the first two oil spills, (to hide the spills).

The seventh mistake was not acting in a timely manner, forcing Veach Land to call the COGCC to put pressure on Monument Global to act on the two spills.

The eighth mistake is not working with the Owner's on a clean up plan that is satisfactory to both parties.

The ninth mistake is having the third oil spill and not replacing the flow lines, which the second and third spill can be considered Criminal Negligence, knowing that the flow lines are over 50 years old.

The tenth mistake is claiming to trespass the surface Landowner on his own property in an effort to clean up Monuments Environmental Disaster, and refusal to work with the Landowners.

Last of all, Monument Global ignoring CRS 34-60-106(3.5).

These drainage's are essential for cattle grazing, If the Landowner's cannot get Monument Global to clean up their Environmental Hazard to their satisfaction, do you think Monument will pay for any cattle that die because of contamination of the drainage?

The simple fact of the matter is that Monument was trying to hide the first two spills by non reporting and ignoring the Landowner inquires into the matter, if it was not for COGCC stepping in to get Monument talking about the spills the Landowners would still be hearing from Tom Fox "Carrie Smith hasn't call you" and act surprised.
