Kiki,

The number of exceptions requested in the Sundry Notice will have to be amended from 1 to 4. Under Rule 609 an exception is required for every sample that is not collected. So, since samples will not be collected you will need 4 exceptions. If two samples had been collected you need 2 exceptions on the Sundry. The number of samples and exception needs to add up to 4.

I can make the necessary changes to the Sundry with your approval.
