Please consider this email as an official approval from COGCC to backfill the pits. Spill reports will be closed as soon as COGCC gets confirmation that the pits have been back filled.

I have reviewed the two form 04s that you submitted via pdf. Confirmation samples from the bottom of the pits show that both blow-down pits, the dehydrator and separator pits, are now in compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 values. Impacted material was sent to an authorized landfill. Please go ahead and back fill the pits.

To simplify the paperwork, please submit the e-form 04 when the pits have been back filled adding a comment to the original form 04s (pits have been back filled). I will close the spill reports as soon as I get the e-form 04s.

Thanks Carlos. Sorry about leaving out the 7 in the tracking numbers.

I can certainly do that. The BLM wanted the bottom of the pits to meet 910-1 in regards to hydrocarbons. We have that. The SAR exceeds on the separator pit at 4 feet but with clean native material on top we'll be isolated from the root zone for vegetative regrowth per the 1000 series rule. Hope that makes sense. I'll send you the forms so you can review them.

I will have John submit the e-Forms when he gets back from vacation. As always if you have any additional questions please don't hesitate to give me a call.

I'll send them in two files to ensure they are not too large.
