RE: Churchill 28J-HZ, Meeting Certification

Date of meeting: 1/2/2014

Time of meeting: 6:30 P.M.

Location of meeting: Platte Valley Fire Station

The following concerns were addressed:

- Road access to location – CR 53 will be used for access into the location. All traffic will be routed from the south to avoid the Town of Kersey.
- Sound mitigation – PDC plans to use a full blanket soundwall to mitigate noise.
- Light mitigation – Lighting will be provided during drilling and completion operations to ensure worker safety and compliance with all regulations. To the extent practicable, site lighting shall be directed downward and inward and shielded so as to avoid glare on public roads and building units within one thousand (1000) feet. A soundwall will also provide light mitigation.
- Truck traffic – Trucks will access locations via CR 53. After completions two to three trucks will be accessing the locations per day. This will decrease after the first few months of operation.
- Location of production facility / aesthetics - Living fences have not been successful in the past. PDC is looking into alternate ways of improving overall aesthetics.

Date of meeting: 5/21/14

Time of meeting: 6:30 P.M.

Location of meeting: Evans Community Complex

The following concerns were addressed:

- Road access to location – CR 53 will be used for access into the location. All traffic will be routed from the south to avoid the Town of Kersey. PDC is working with the school district and has identified times and general location of bus routes. Traffic will be kept to a minimum during those times on bus routes.
- Sound mitigation – A baseline sound survey has been completed to determine ambient noise levels. PDC plans to use a 32 foot full blanket sound wall for the location.
- Light mitigation – Lighting will be provided during drilling and completion operations to ensure worker safety and compliance with all regulations. To the extent practicable, site lighting shall be directed downward and inward and shielded so as to avoid glare on public roads and building units within one thousand (1000) feet. A 32 foot soundwall will be installed to also provide light mitigation.
- Truck traffic – Trucks will access locations via CR 53. The production facility location has been moved 1,000 feet to the south. This will decrease overall truck traffic substantially around the Rangeview Ranch Subdivision.
- Location of production facility / aesthetics – PDC changed the overall plan and has moved the production facility 1,000 feet to the south. The overall number of tanks has also been reduced.
