

WELL ABANDONMENT REPORT

This form is to be submitted as an Intent to Abandon whenever an abandonment is planned on a borehole. After the abandonment is complete, this form shall again be submitted as a Subsequent Report of the actual work completed. The approved intent shall be valid for six months after the approval date, after that period, a new intent will be required. Attachments required with the Intent to Abandon are wellbore diagrams of the current configuration and the proposed configuration with plugs set.
 A Subsequent Report of Abandonment shall indicate the actual work completed. Attachments required with a Subsequent Report are a wellbore diagram showing plugs that were set and casing remaining in the hole, the job summaries from all plugging contractors used, including wireline and cementing (third party verification) and any logs that may have been run during abandonment.

Details: The scope of this work is to re-enter the old wellbore that had previously been plugged and abandoned. The well will be properly plugged and abandoned by setting cement plugs to isolate the Niobrara formation, freshwater zones, and setting a cement cap near the surface. Then the surface casing will have a plate welled as final seal 5' below the surface. The old wellbore will then be buried and the surface location will be remediated.
