This email is to notify you that the AP 521-20-695 on the AP 21-20-695 pad has a low top of cement. Details of this well include:

AP 521-20-695 (05-045-21377)- MV Well

- This well is a new drill
- Top of Cement- 6,262'
- This well **does not** cover 200' above the top of the Mesa Verde (Geology pick: 6,175')
- This well **does** cover the top of gas (Geology pick:7,562)
- Bradenhead pressure is 20 psi
- The planned top perf depth is below the top of gas

This well is scheduled to frac on 8/1/2014. Please advise.
