This letter hereby certifies that Ward Petroleum Corporation (Ward) complied with Rule 306.e. for the above referenced Oil and Gas Location. Ward did not receive any requests for meetings or consultations during the comment period.

Ward participated in two meetings including a private meeting with a concerned resident on January 7, 2014 wherein the drilling and completions process was explained. Ward detailed noise and light mitigation that would be used as well as access noise concerns.

Ward also met with the Silver Springs at Todd Creek Farms HOA on May 17, 2014. Concerns regarding noise, light and traffic were discussed as well as housekeeping issues including weed control. As a follow up to this meeting, Ward's contractor met with residents onsite on May 19, 2014 to discuss mitigation efforts on housekeeping issues for a well that Ward became the operator of in the area, as well as for the above referenced oil and gas location.

I spoke with several residents on the phone after they received the Pre-Application notification, where I was able to answer questions and discuss their concerns.
