Mr. Schlagenhauf:

Sovereign Operating Company LLC requests an extension on a Mechanical Integrity Test (MIT) for its Hefley A-1 well in Baca County, Colorado.

The well has been shut in since it last produced in June 2012. A MIT was required this year and we were ready to do it but the well is in a cornfield and the farmer requested we wait.

I have attached a letter from Mr. Kevin Hefley of H2O Farms requesting that we wait until the corn crop is harvested, around October 15<sup>th</sup>.

Because of electronic problems the well could not be produced. We plan to MIT the well within two weeks of the completion of the corn harvest (around October 31st). At that time we might also plan to work over the well and put it back on production.

We are very sorry that we did not get the MIT done on time but did not realize that access might be a problem.
