Angie,

The above documents need to be corrected prior to being accepted by the COGCC. The forms request 1 exception to rule 609 however, if there are not wells to sample you need to request 4 exceptions. Basically an exception should be requested for each of the required 4 samples that is not collected. So if you had 2 samples you would need to request 2 exceptions to Rule 609. In these cases you have 0 samples so you should be requesting 4 exceptions.
