An addendum to the approved Form 27 should be submitted and if the operator is requesting no further action (NFA) regarding remediation of the Facility, then that should be stated. The addendum should include detailed descriptions of activities and actions that the operator took regarding remediation of the Facility, and should address the COAs of the approved Form 27. Upon receipt of this information COGCC EPS staff will review this information in a timely manner and respond with a request for additional information (if necessary) or issue a NFA.

Per Rule 1003.e.(3) and 1004.c. a Sundry Form 4 shall be submitted as it relates to reclamation.

I have copied Denise Arthur (Reclamation Supervisor) and Amanda Goodwin (Reclamation Specialist) regarding the operators request *"to begin reclamation activities (weather permitting) within the next few weeks, in accordance with COGCC 1000 series rules and landowner COA's."*

Please get with Denise and Amanda regarding the reclamation and your request including the "landowner COAs.

Mr. Fischer,

Ursa Operating Company LLC (Ursa) is pleased to inform you that the Lundgren Centralized E&P Facility (REM #8407, Facility ID 149019) has been remediated, and all contaminated soils have been excavated and disposed to ECDC Environmental in East Carbon, Utah. This includes the contaminated soils discussed in the status summary submitted to you on October 15, 2014 in which Ursa showed that impacted soils extended from the northeast corner to the southwest corner of the facility; approximately 1-2 ft. below ground surface, and an area of concern (AOC) in the middle with impacts extending to approximately 10ft. Confirmation analytical results indicate that soils satisfy COGCC Table 910-1. I have attached some photographs to show the excavation process.

The action to close this facility and conduct site characterization/remediation was undertaken at Ursa's initiative to close out legacy issues that existing prior to Ursa acquiring the asset. Ursa is therefore requesting COGCC approval to begin reclamation activities (weather permitting) within the next few weeks, in accordance with COGCC 1000 series rules and landowner COA's. Once reclamation has been completed, a final Notice of Completion (NOC) report will be provided to you, outlining the initial investigation, site characterization, sampling procedures and results, and reclamation activities.
