In response to Inspection #675200915, conducted December 05, 2014, Encana has inspected the location and identified the stormwater corrective actions identified in the above mentioned inspection.

Encana has completed the following surface stabilization measures: rilling on cutslope was raked out, cutslope was seeded and amendments were applied to prevent future erosion and facilitate vegetative growth; damaged wattles were replaced, and additional wattles were installed in the diversion under the cutslope and on the fill slope to prevent future rilling; the berms around the sediment traps were repaired; roadside ditch was compacted and re-pulled to repair undercutting; rutting on the working surface and road was smoothed out.
