Extraction Oil and Gas (Extraction) plans to drill the above referenced wells, specifically described as:

<b>Kodak #3</b>	<b>1245' FNL, 1043' FWL</b>
<b>Kodak #5</b>	<b>1277' FNL, 1043' FWL</b>
<b>Kodak #6</b>	<b>1293' FNL, 1043' FWL</b>
<b>Kodak #9</b>	<b>1325' FNL, 1042' FWL</b>
<b>Kodak #10</b>	<b>1341' FNL, 1042' FWL</b>
<b>Kodak #13</b>	<b>1389' FNL, 1042' FWL</b>

These wells are being proposed at a distance less than the required 150' feet from the surface property line, as described in COGCC Rule 603.a.(2), which states that a well "...shall not be located less than 150 feet from a surface property line.". The Surface Use Agreement is attached to the sundries and permit and the setback being waived in the SUA and is highlighted.

Extraction requests an exception to COGCC Rule 603.a.(2) in order to drill the subject wells. Extraction respectfully requests the COGCC review the enclosed information and approve the requested setback waiver and Application for Permit to drill for the subject wells.
