John:

I am currently auditing historic complaints, spills and remediations to determine if any can be closed and/or resolved. As a result, I will be systematically sending out these requests on an individual basis.

PDC had a spill at the subject location on 12/14/2009 and a Form 19 – Spill/Release Report was submitted to the COGCC on 12/31/2009 (Spill #1631831). The Form 19 stated that a Form 27 – Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan would be submitted subsequently. The spill record in COGIS remains open.

Impacted soil was removed in a timely manner and confirmation samples were collected on 1/10/2010. Laboratory results indicated soil conditions within the Table 910-1 standards. A Form 27 was generated upon receipt of the lab report. However due to an apparent oversight on our part, a Form 27 and supporting documentation were never submitted to the COGCC.

Please find attached a Form 27 and supporting documentation for your review. Based on the information provided, PDC requests that a remediation project number be assigned and that Spill #1631831 and the remediation project be closed.

Your assistance in this matter is appreciated. I apologize for any inconvenience this oversight has caused.
