COGCC has reviewed the Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan submitted by Bayswater Exploration and Production on December 5, 2014. Bayswater submitted the Form 27 in response to COGCC's request for Bayswater to investigate current conditions at the location with respect to Remediation Project #3437, which was opened in 2005 by Energy Oil & Gas, Inc., the previous Operator of the Clark 1-25 well.

Based on the information presented in Bayswater's Form 27, it appears that all corrective actions required by Remediation Project #3437 were completed and no impacts remain as a result of the spill documented in 2005. Therefore, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time, and COGCC approves the closure request.

However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soil exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site.

In addition, closure of this project does not preclude the need for future investigation required by Rule 905.b. for the removal of a buried or partially buried vessel, or the need to fully investigate and remediate any future release that may occur or be discovered at this location.
