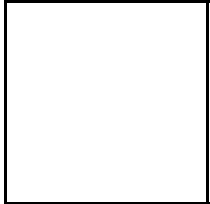

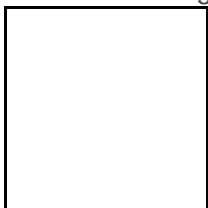
Just to confirm that EE3 is in concurrence with the following wildlife BMPs for the Rich 2-32H (Doc#: 400762868) proposed pad location:

1. Where oil and gas activities must occur within mapped greater sage-grouse production habitat, conduct all construction, drilling, and completions activities outside the period between March 1 and June 30. **Agreed**
2. Establish company guidelines (i.e. slow speeds and increased awareness among employees and contractors) to minimize wildlife mortality from vehicle collisions on roadways. **Agreed**
3. Where operations allow, consider the use of an internal combustor system or enclosed flare device for disposal of gases encountered during drilling and production. Avoiding traditional flaring techniques at this location will mitigate the effects of fugitive light and noise on wildlife. **Agreed**
4. Use hospital grade mufflers for compressors, pump jacks, or other motors necessary to run operations at the site. Point mufflers upwards to dissipate potential vibration. **Agreed; provided mufflers are not necessary for electric motors.**
5. Install and utilize bear-proof trash receptacles for all food related waste, following COGCC Rule 1204 a-1. **Agreed**

Let me know if there are any edits or alterations we can discuss. Otherwise, if EE3 agrees to the following recommendations, I'll get them entered in our comments on the Form2A permit.
