On March 31, 2015, COGCC contacted Sandy Clinger to inquire about her comment concerning noise and visual impacts from the proposed SG Interests I LTD, Falcon Seaboard 11-90-12 #3 Pad, NESW Sec 12 T11S R90W, Gunnison County, Form 2A#400653954. COGCC reviewed with Ms. Clinger SG's response to her request that "SG install hay/straw bales, high enough to shield them from the multiple wells (4) to be drilled on the well pad both during and after drilling as well as during the remainder of the installation process." COGCC indicated to her that visual mitigation would be a voluntary measure for the operator, especially since her house was 6000' from the well pad. In addition, COGCC reiterated that during construction of the well pad, as well as during drilling and completion of the wells, the operator needed to meet the Light Industrial noise levels of 70 db(A) in the hours between 7:00 am and the next 7:00 pm and 65 db(A) in the hours between 7:00 pm and the next 7:00 am. These levels would need to be met at 350 feet from the drill rig. COGCC also indicated to Ms. Clinger that her comment, the map provided by SG showing the well pad in relation to her house, and both COGCC's and SG's responses would be attached to the Form 2A#400953742.
