As per our phone conversation, the HSR-Rewank 4-7A (05-123-15027) and Frey 13-6A (05-123-15009) have adequate surface coverage, SX coverage, and NIO coverage, and Form 17's were submitted for both wells on March 24, 2015. Both forms showed no pressure on the Bradenhead, so with this new information, we feel the COA's should be lifted. Again, if you could have this just within the next few days that would be great.
