Dear Director Lepore,

Carrizo (Niobrara) LLC hereby requests that the Director grant an exception under Rule 317.p. Carrizo was unable to get a resistivity log down to the kick off point (KOP) on the Hemberger 5-26-8-60 and other wells on the pad as mentioned above. Open hole logs were provided within a 1500' radius for the following wells:

Duell 1-26, API 123-09031, well log doc #926328 & 988467  
Duell B #1 API 123-05496, well log doc #945157  
Frank & John Duell et al #1-A, API 123-13758, well log doc #984188 & 984187

In addition, Carrizo will submit the CBL and MWD (measured while drilling) with gamma ray on all wells from TD to kick off point. A compensated neutron log with gamma ray will be provided for the Hemberger 5-26-8-60.

Carrizo is certain that the logs to be provided at completion will satisfy the adequate description of the stratigraphy of the wellbore, will verify the depth of surface casing and also verify any aquifer coverage.
