Hey Doug and John,

I have attached Edge Energy's summary of consultation that occurred with the building unit owner that is within the buffer zone of the Long 22-B Pad wells. Contained within the summary are the concerns that the BUO had regarding the Long 22-B Pad as well as what Edge Energy is going to do in response to those concerns. Below are some changes to BMPs and/or comments that were originally listed on the Long 22-B Pad Form 2A:

Visual Mitigation: Please remove in the comments that Edge Energy will install landscaping. Edge Energy does not believe that the BUO view of the mountains will be obstructed since the site is in a valley that is 20 ft below the BUO.

Noise Mitigation: Please add the following to the Noise BMP: "Edge Energy plans to hire a qualified sound consultant to conduct a noise survey and model the specific drilling rig to be used for the drilling operations. Edge will use the results of the model to design a noise mitigation program, up to and including the use of engineered sound walls, to be in compliance with COGCC rules.

Traffic Control: Please add the following to the Traffic Control BMP: "Edge will post an appropriate sign indicating that the nearby BUO driveway is a private road and that no turn-around will be allowed by Edge personnel or its contractors."

I believe that this will be the only changes that will need to be made to the permit, as the rest of the BUO concerns are adequately addressed by existing BMPs and surface owner consultations.
