I have attached two documents which indicate that KC Resources is the operator of the AR Davis Well No. 1, AR Davis Well No. 2 and AR Davis Central Tank Battery (CTB).

One (KCRvUSGOV.pdf) is a copy of the Court Decision on a legal action that was filed by KC Resources against the US Government. There is quite a bit of relevant information about operatorship of the AR Davis wells within this document.

The second (BLMLetter20140717.pdf) is a copy of a letter that BLM sent to Fairfield and Woods (the attorneys representing KC Resources, Inc. and Crystal River Oil & Gas, LLC). It also contains information regarding operatorship for the two wells and the CDP (i.e. CTB) facility.
