Paul,

I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and have the following comments.

1) You have indicated that only one well will be drilled on this location, yet there will be 8 tanks (6 oil tanks & 2 water tanks) to contain the fluids produced by this well. This is atypical of the number of tanks we usually see to service a single well. Will you provide some reasoning as to why 8 tanks are proposed for this single well?

2) You have indicated that a Land Application Site will be permitted prior to spud. Therefore I would like to add the following Condition of Approval: *"Operator shall submit a Land Application Plan to the COGCC via a Form 4 Sundry. The Land Application Plan must be approved by the COGCC prior to drilling."*
