Below are some bullet points addressing the placement of the English Farms Tank Battery.

- o Surface Owner has future plans to develop the property and requested the facility location to provide compatibility for the surface and mineral development .
- o The surface owner farms this property and requested the facility be located at the proposed location to reduce impact to center pivot irrigation system. An expansion of the existing facility would have expanded into center pivot irrigation. This area is farmed as feed for his cattle.
- o Existing facility will be removed and incorporated into proposed facility.
 - o Due to COGCC set-back rules we need to stay 75' away from the wellheads with our facility. The English Farms XX08-72HN Horizontal well drilled by Noble now operated by Kerr-McGee well is Northeast of the wells we will be drilling and east of the existing tank battery.
 - o There are buried electrical lines and a road right-of-way along WCR 41 that needs to be avoided east of the existing tank battery where you had suggested we put the tank battery.
 - o The only option to expand the existing tank battery was to go East which would place the tank battery about 100' from the homeowner that is located in the middle of the two well pads, This location would also result in us disturbing some of the farmers crop.
 - o The tank battery was designed to have the separators at the far side of the facility to help with the noise.
