We mailed the EPA a letter yesterday, and sent a copy to you as well. We told them that we would not be able to provide the requested information within 15 days, for reasons which are outlined in the letter. We will put together a reply for them by the end of October. We reclaimed the Keegan Patrick #3B well location at the end of June of this year, so that pit no longer exists. We have also reclaimed the Mollie Corynne #3B pit. We are still waiting for the 2 Mary Catherine pits to dry up, and then we will reclaim them as well.
