Negotiations of access & well sites with operator have just begun. However, LIMITED ACCESS TO OUR 45 ACRES MAY result IN A PROPOSED LOCATION THAT ADVERSELY impacts OUR Public Safety & Health, along with the Environment that MAY NOT be Adequately Addressed by COGCC rules or ORDERS. IF FEDERAL LANDS (which border us on 3 sides) CONTINUE to be exempt from surface use (even for access), Adverse impacts will result from the limited options remaining on our Northern boundary which includes an easement across neighbor's land, also 2 Potential wells (4 TOTAL wells on 115 acres)
