Doug,

I realize that we discussed the BMPs and timing restrictions during the onsite of this location, but could we get your official concurrence on CPW's recommended BMPs for this location? The BMPs that we agreed upon at the onsite were:

1. Where oil and gas activities (construction, drilling, and completions) must occur within 4 miles of greater sage-grouse leks or within other mapped greater sage-grouse breeding or summer habitat, conduct these activities outside the period between March 1 and June 30.
2. Restrict well site visitations (excluding emergency situations) to portions of the day between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. during the lekking season (March 1 to May 15).

3.
Restore appropriate sagebrush species or subspecies on disturbed sagebrush sites, if agreeable by the landowner. Use locally collected seed for reseeding where possible.

4.
Utilize internal combustors/flaring devices to minimize the noise and light impacts associated with traditional flaring techniques.

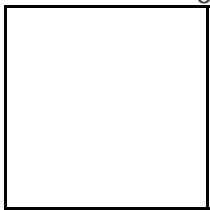
5.
Establish company guidelines to minimize wildlife mortality from vehicle collisions on roadways.

6.
Install and utilize bear-proof dumpsters and trash receptacles for all food-related trash on location, following COGCC Rule 1204 a-1.

7.
Relocate the access road to avoid fragmentation of existing GrSG habitat.
Coordinate
with local CPW personnel while surveying new route.

Thanks Doug. This will allow Dave K. to get these BMPs officially entered on the Form2A permit.
