COMMENTS:

This form is being submitted as a Notification of Completion for a cuttings remediation project (7601), and to document onsite burial of drill cuttings during interim reclamation efforts completed September 18, 2012 on the C100U well pad (334093).

After completion of drilling operations, a representative composite sample of the drill cuttings stockpile was collected and submitted to a laboratory for analysis of COGCC Table 910-1 constituents of concern. Initial results in 2010 and 2011 identified TPH-DRO concentrations above allowable limits. Additional samples in early 2012 confirmed the presence of elevated TPH-DRO concentrations. A more thorough sampling effort involving the use of a track-hoe was undertaken in 2012 to ascertain whether impacts were consistent throughout the stockpile. Upon receipt of results showing the persistent presence of TPH-DRO impacts, a Form 27 was submitted to propose a remediation approach. During remediation efforts, the cuttings stockpile was laid out on the pad and amended with manure, compost, and fertilizer, and watered to promote bioremediation. Prior to final placement of the stockpile in preparation for burial during interim reclamation, three composite samples were collected. One of the composite samples had a slightly elevated concentration, while the other two composite samples were below the allowable concentration, and the average concentration for the three samples is below the allowable concentration. Upon receipt of laboratory results indicating compliance with 900 Series Rules, the drill cuttings status was communicated to construction and operations personnel for reclamation scheduling.

During interim reclamation, approximately 11,000 cubic yards of drill cuttings were buried on the southwest side of the location. The cuttings were placed and oriented to maximize the depth of the native material cap, and to assure that the stockpile remained below the agronomic zone during future reoccupations or final reclamation. To assure successful revegetation during reclamation, a minimum of three feet of native material is used to cap all impacted and potentially impacted material.

The inorganic constituents EC and SAR were above the allowable limits, but the cuttings stockpile was buried below the agronomic zone where these constituents should have no effect on revegetation efforts. Encana requests that the COGCC consider the reclamation purpose of listing the inorganic constituents and the physical disposition of these materials as an alternative to the allowable levels listed in COGCC Table 910-1.

The metal constituent arsenic is also above the allowable limit, but is within the range of background values for this area. Based on these results and Footnote 1 to COGCC Table 910-1, Encana requests that the COGCC consider the higher range of background arsenic values as the allowable concentration for this constituent.
