

WELL ABANDONMENT REPORT

The approved intent shall be valid for six months after the approval date, after that period, a new intent will be required. Attachments required with the Intent to Abandon are wellbore diagrams of the current configuration and the proposed configuration with plugs set.
 A Subsequent Report of Abandonment shall indicate the actual work completed. Attachments required with a Subsequent Report are a wellbore diagram showing plugs that were set and casing remaining in the hole, the job summaries from all plugging contractors used, including wireline and cementing (third party verification) and any logs that may have been run during abandonment.

If surface casing plug is not circulated to surface then tag plug – must be 240' or shallower and provide 10 sx plug at the surface. Leave at least 100' cement in the casing for each plug. 3) Properly abandon flowlines as per Rule 1103. File electronic Form 42 once abandonment complete.
