Bob,

Thank you for sending this in. I will date stamp it received today and file accordingly as notification of the release. You will still need to enter an eForm 19 into the system as soon as possible. Unfortunately I am not able to do that on your behalf. Please also be sure to notify the surface owner and the local government in accordance with Rule 906 (if that hasn't been done) and document that notification on your eForm 19 submittal.

I've also attached for your reference the Rule 1101 Flowline Guidance document. When you have repaired the flowline and you're ready to test it, COGCC will require a flowline integrity test. It will need to be witnessed by COGCC staff and properly documented.

Please keep track of any soil disposal documentation and call me or email me at least one day in advance when you are ready to collect samples.

Thank you again for proceeding with the required cleanup and documentation.
