Hi Kelsi

The COGCC has completed the technical review of the above-referenced Form 42 and identified the following inconsistencies,

1) The Public Road to the north of the location appears closer than 1 mile. Please verify distance. I have contacted our field team to verify this distance- I will let you know as soon as I hear back from them!

Also, with your concurrence, the COGCC can make the following changes. Please go ahead and make all changes you've listed below (#1-3).

1) The COGCC can change the Estimated Depth to Groundwater to 21 feet based on DWR Permit #6601

2) The COGCC can change Sensitive Area to YES.

3) The COGCC can change Basis Statement to read "Receipt #3636442, Permit #6601".

In addition, the following Conditions of Approval have been applied to the Form 2A. **We accept both COAs.**

1) Location lies within proximity of a surface water drainage. Operator shall use tertiary containment along the cross- and down-gradient perimeters of the edge of disturbance.

2) Operator shall provide notice to COGCC 48 hours prior to commencing construction of this Oil and Gas Location via Form 42.
