The Operator is required to contact COGCC Engineering Staff with in 10 days of the date of this inspection report for approval of a schedule for either performing an MIT, or Plugging and Abandoning the well. If the MIT option is selected the well must pass an MIT to become compliant. The operator must provide ten (10) days written notice, via Form 42, to the field inspector prior to the MIT as required by Rule. If the MIT is not completed prior to a date approved by Engineering Staff or the well fails the MIT this matter will be referred to COGCC Enforcement Staff for formal proceedings. It will be to the operator's benefit to correct the violation immediately, though completion of required corrective action (s) will not eliminate the imposition of a penalty for past noncompliance.

ACTION REQUIRED

ANY ACTION REQUIRED items listed on this report indicate that the oil and gas facility or the oil and gas operations listed on the report may be in violation of the rules and regulations of the Colorado Oil and Conservation Commission (“COGCC”) and corrective action is required.

There is reasonable cause to believe that a violation of the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, or of any rule, regulation, or order of the Commission, or of any permit issued by the Commission, has occurred. The Operator’s compliance with this Inspection Report is required to resolve these alleged violations. This document requires the Operator to timely respond to the COGCC and to comply with directives as listed by the **Corrective Action Deadline Date**. Failure to do so will result in the issuance of a Notice of Alleged Violation and initiation of enforcement proceedings in which COGCC will seek monetary penalties for the alleged violations pursuant to § 34-60-121, C.R.S. and Rule 523, COGCC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1. (Please note that the COGCC's penalty authority was recently increased to a maximum of \$15,000 per day and penalties are no longer capped at a maximum of \$10,000 per violation.)
