I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and have the following comments.

1) In the Facilities section you have indicated there will be six (6) oil tanks on this proposed oil and gas location. However, your Facility Layout Drawing (Interim Reclamation Plan Figure #4) you depict twelve (12) oil tanks. Please confirm the number of oil tanks proposed for this oil and gas location.

2) In the Cultural Distance section you have indicated the nearest Public Road is 548 feet from the nearest proposed well and 429 feet from the nearest proposed production facility. A review of your Location Drawing (Figure #5) appears to indicate these are the distances to the existing road to the northeast of this proposed oil and gas location. That existing road appears to be the access road for your nearby Fox Creek #1-35H well pad. For purposes of the Form 2A, existing Operator access roads should not be considered when determining the distance to the nearest Public Road. The nearest Public Road, appears to be CR 136.5 to the north and northwest. Therefore, please provide me with the two distances (nearest well and nearest production facility) to that County Road.

Figure 4 is correct. There will be 12 Oil tanks. Please make this correction. Sorry for the confusion.

- 2) In the Cultural Distance section you have indicated the nearest Public Road is 548 feet from the nearest proposed well and 429 feet from the nearest proposed production facility. A review of your Location Drawing (Figure #5) appears to indicate these are the distances to the existing road to the northeast of this proposed oil and gas location. That existing road appears to be the access road for your nearby Fox Creek #1-35H well pad. For purposes of the Form 2A, existing Operator access roads should not be considered when determining the distance to the nearest Public Road. The nearest Public Road, appears to be CR 136.5 to the north and northwest. Therefore, please provide me with the two distances (nearest well and nearest production facility) to that County Road.

There are in fact 12 oil tanks on location, Figure #4 is correct.

2) In the Cultural Distance section you have indicated the nearest Public Road is 548 feet from the nearest proposed well and 429 feet from the nearest proposed production facility. A review of your Location Drawing (Figure #5) appears to indicate these are the distances to the existing road to the northeast of this proposed oil and gas location. That existing road appears to be the access road for your nearby Fox Creek #1-35H well pad. For purposes of the Form 2A, existing Operator access roads should not be considered when determining the distance to the nearest Public Road. The nearest Public Road, appears to be CR 136.5 to the north and northwest. Therefore, please provide me with the two distances (nearest well and nearest production facility) to that County Road.

The distance from the closest Public Road (CR 136.5) to the nearest proposed well should be 1169' and from production facilities it should be 1048'.
