Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (“KMG”) respectfully requests approval of an exception to Rule 318A.c to allow the above-named wells to be drilled at the above-referenced location. Rule 318A.c of the COGCC’s Rules and Regulations requires any new twinning well to be located within fifty (50) feet of an existing well. The above-named wells are more than fifty (50) feet from the nearest existing oil and gas well. The above-named wells are being permitted as an exception location at the request of the surface owner.
